An Act to Eliminate the Requirement for a Separate Application for Lands within the Settlement Corridor to be Entered into the Spruce-Fir Forest Protection District. Presented by Rep. Michaud of East Millinocket; Co-sponsored by Sen. Pearson of Penobscot, Rep. Moholland of Princeton, Rep. Masterman of Milo. Energy & Natural Resources Hearing 1-30-84. O.T.P. Accepted. Enacted, Approved 2-24-84, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 623.
