An Act to Allow Elderly Persons to have Pets in Public Housing. Presented by Sen. Wood of York; Co-sponsored by Sen. Bustin of Kennebec, Sen. Gill of Cumberland. Health & Institutional Services Hearing 3-12-84. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by House; Minority OTP-AM Accepted by Senate. In House - Adhered to Majority Report; In Senate - Adhered to Engrossed with CA & SA. Died Between Houses.
