LD 2300 / HP1746

An Act to Establish a Policy and Procedure for Law Enforcement Officers Engaged in the Pursuit of Fleeing or Speeding Vehicles. Presented by Rep. Carroll of Limerick; Co-sponsored by Rep. Perry of Mexico. Judiciary Hearing 3-27-84. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted in Senate (Minority O.T.P.). In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
