HP1586

Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife report out a bill to the House addressing the financial needs of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Presented by Rep. MacEachern of Lincoln. Passed in Concurrence, 2-17-84. (See LD 2320)
