LD 2478 / HP1876

Original Title: An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$12,900,000 for Capital Improvements, Construction, Renovations, Equipment and Furnishings for Vocational-Technical Institutes. New Title: An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$13,425,000 for Capital Improvements, Construction, Renovations, Equipment and Furnishings for Vocational-Technical Institutes and to Provide Funds for the Procurement of a Tugboat to be Used for Training Purposes at the Maine Maritime Academy.
