HP1048

An Act to Amend the Law Establishing a Commercial Tag for Atlantic Salmon to Exempt Indians and Persons under 16 Years of Age. Presented by Rep. Ruhlin of Brewer; Co-sponsored by Rep. Murphy of Kennebunk, Rep. Diamond of Bangor, Sen. Perkins of Hancock. Indefinitely Postponed in House; Referred to the Committee on Fisheries and Wildlife and Ordered Printed, in Senate. In House - Adhered. Died Between Houses.
