LD 39 / HP0037 (ND 897 / HP0643)

An Act to Deny Certain State Funds to Any Person Who Refuses to Register Under the United States Military Selective Services Act. Presented by Rep. Paradis of Old Town; Co-sponsored by Rep. Greenlaw of Standish, Rep. McSweeney of Old Orchard Beach, Sen. Brown of Washington. Legal Affairs Hearing 01-30-85. Majority OTP-ND Accepted (Minority O.N.T.P.). NEW DRAFT: HP0643 / LD 897. House - Adhered to Enact; Senate - Adhered to Fail to Enact. Died Between Houses.
