An Act to Establish Policies Governing Smoking in Places of Work. Presented by Rep. Nelson of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Dexter of Kingfield, Rep. Pines of Limestone, Sen. Violette of Aroostook. Human Resources Hearing 02-27-85. Majority OTP-AM Accepted (Minority OTP-AM). Amended by: CA H-53. Enacted, Approved 04-26-85, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 126.
