An Act to Reduce the Length of the First Legislative Session from 100 Days to 90 Days and Set a Calendar Deadline of June 15th and Reduce the Length of the 2nd Legislative Session from 50 Days to 40 Days and Set a Calendar Deadline of April 15th.
