LD 520 / HP0379

An Act to Provide a Referendum to Abolish County Government and Authorize Reassignment of its Functions and Duties to Appropriate State and Municipal Agencies. Presented by Rep. Carter of Winslow; Co-sponsored by Rep. Paradis of Augusta, Rep. Martin of Eagle Lake, Sen. Baldacci of Penobscot. Local & County Government Hearing 04-29-85. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority OTP-AM. House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
