LD 647 / SP0252

An Act to Allow a Landlord to Enter a Rental Unit if the Rental Unit Reasonably Appears to have been Vacated Permanently and no Notice has been Given. Presented by Sen. Maybury of Penobscot; Co-sponsored by Rep. Handy of Lewiston, Rep. Murphy of Berwick. Legal Affairs Hearing 04-09-85. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted (Minority O.T.P.).
