An Act to Require Legislative Review and Approval of Sales and Use Tax Exemptions Every 5 Years. Presented by Sen. Twitchell of Oxford; Co-sponsored by Rep. Jackson of Harrison. Taxation Hearing 02-10-86. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by House; Minority OTP-AM Accepted by Senate. Died Between Houses.
