An Act to Impose a Moratorium on the Licensing of Commercial Landfills for the Disposal of Solid Waste. Presented by Sen. Tuttle of York; Co-sponsored by Sen. Matthews of Kennebec, Rep. Cooper of Windham, Rep. Ridley of Shapleigh. Energy & Natural Resources. (Majority OTP-AM) (Minority OTP-AM). Amended by: SB S-572. Emergency Enacted, Approved 10-23-86, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 822.
