AN ACT to Improve Legislative and Public Access to the Agency Rule-making Process. (Reported Pursuant to a Study by the Local & County Government Committee). State and Local Government Hearing 03/18/87. OTP-ND Accepted 05/22/87. NEW DRAFT: HP1210 / LD 1651, NEW TITLE: AN ACT to Establish Greater Communication in the Rule-making Process and to Provide Better Standards for the Adoption of Rules. Amended by: SA S-256. Enacted. Pursuant to Joint Order HP 1376, this Bill was Recalled from the Governor's Desk and Recommitted to the State and Local Government Committee. Pursuant to Joint Order SP 660, this Bill was Carried Over from a Previous Session. Majority OTP-ND Accepted 04/06/88 (Minority OTP-ND: HP1913 / LD 2612). NEW DRAFT: HP1912 / LD 2611, NEW TITLE: AN ACT to Establish Greater Communication in the Rule-Making Process and to Provide Better Standards for the Adoption of Rules. Indefinitely Postponed.
