LD 1073 / HP0799

AN ACT to Require that Loads of Gravel, Sand, Crushed Stone, Wood Chips, Building Debris or Rubbish be Secure to Prevent Spillage. Presented by Rep. Racine of Biddeford; Cosponsored by Rep. Reeves of Pittston, Rep. Allen of Washington, and Rep. Greenlaw of Standish. Transportation Hearing 05/11/87. Minority OTP Accepted 05/20/87 (Majority ONTP). Enacted, Approved 06/05/87, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 227.
