AN ACT Concerning the Volunteer Marine Patrol Program. Presented by Rep. Salsbury of Bar Harbor; Co-sponsored by Sen. Tuttle of York, Rep. Rice of Stonington, and Rep. Look of Jonesboro. Marine Resources Hearing 02/09/88. Majority ONTP Accepted by House; Minority OTP Accepted by Senate. House - Adhered to ONTP. Died Between Houses.
