RESOLVE, to Study a Program to Promote the Purchase of State-Grown Produce by Needy Persons. Presented by Sen. Pray of Penobscot; Co-sponsored by Rep. Tardy of Palmyra, Sen. Matthews of Kennebec, and Sen. Black of Cumberland. Agriculture Hearing 03/16/88. Majority ONTP Accepted by House; Minority OTP Accepted by Senate. House - Adhered to ONTP; Senate - Adhered to Engrossment. Died Between Houses.
