LD 2506 / HP1830

AN ACT to Improve Comprehensive Land Use Planning and Land Use Ordinances to Manage Growth and Development. Presented by Rep. Dexter of Kingfield; Co-sponsored by Sen. Perkins of Hancock, and Rep. Anderson of Woodland. Energy & Natural Resources. Minority OTP-AM Accepted by House; Majority ONTP Accepted by Senate. House - Adhered to Engrossing as Amended by CA H-738; Senate - Adhered to ONTP. Died Between Houses.
