LD 242 / HP0177

An Act to Return Certain Positions within the Department of Environmental Protection to Classified Service under the Civil Service Law. Presented by Rep. Ketover of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Oliver of Portland, Sen. Holloway of Lincoln, and Rep. Jacques of Waterville. State and Local Government Hearing 03/08/89. Majority OTP Accepted 04/11/89 (Minority ONTP). Enacted, Approved 05/05/89, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 111.
