Education Hearing 04/19/89. OTP-AM Accepted 06/06/89. Amended by: CA H-334, HA/CA H-383. Enacted. Neither Signed Nor Vetoed by the Governor. Pursuant to Joint Order SP 810 this Bill was Recalled from the Governor's Desk. Recommitted to Education. Final Disposition: Leave to Withdraw Accepted 02/01/90.
