Original Title: An Act to Implement the Governor's Study to Regain Full Use of Maine's Class C Rivers. New Title: An Act to Regain Full Use of Maine's Waters Through the Establishment of Color Standards. Presented by Rep. Nutting of Leeds; Co-sponsored by Rep. Boutilier of Lewiston, Rep. Michaud of East Millinocket, and Sen. Berube of Androscoggin. Energy & Natural Resources Hearing 04/05/89. Majority OTP-AM Accepted 05/01/89 (Minority ONTP). Amended by: CA (Changed Title) H-102. Enacted, Governor Vetoed. House - Recommitted to Energy & Natural Resources; Senate - Adhered to Enactment. Veto Sustained.
