An Act Relating to Notice of Injury for Purposes of Workers' Compensation and Occupational Disease Claims. Presented by Sen. Gauvreau of Androscoggin; Co-sponsored by Sen. Matthews of Kennebec, Rep. Ruhlin of Brewer, and Rep. Rand of Portland. Labor Hearing 04/26/89. Majority OTP-AM Accepted 06/19/89 (Minority ONTP). Amended by: CA S-295, HA/CA H-619. Enacted, Veto Sustained.
