An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$3,000,000 to Protect Ground water Quality and Public Health Through the Cleanup and Closure of Municipal and Abandoned Solid Waste Landfills. Presented by Rep. Foss of Yarmouth; Co-sponsored by Sen. Pearson of Penobscot, Sen. Holloway of Lincoln, and Rep. Ridley of Shapleigh. Appropriations & Financial Affairs Hearing 06/06/89. OTP-AM Accepted 06/16/89. Amended by: CA H-610. Enacted, Approved 07/11/89, P & S LAWS, Chapter 81. Approved in Referendum, 11/07/89 (In favor: 162,246; Opposed: 69,994).
