An Act to Promote Reduction, Recycling and Integrated Management of Solid Waste and Sound Environmental Regulation. Presented by Rep. Michaud of East Millinocket; Co-sponsored by Sen. Erwin of Oxford, Rep. Allen of Washington, and Rep. Whitcomb of Waldo. Energy & Natural Resources. Majority OTP-AM Accepted 06/20/89 (Minority OTP-AM). Amended by: CA H-640, HD/CA H-661, HE/CA H-663, SJ/CA S-397. Enacted, Approved 07/12/89, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 585.
