History and Final Disposition

LD 1911 / HP1380

Original Title: An Act to Return Certain Positions within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to Classified Service under the Civil Service Law and to Establish Uniform Pay Schedules. New Title: An Act to Establish Certain Positions within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation as Unclassified State Positions Subject to the State Employees Labor Relations Act. Presented by Rep. Joseph of Waterville; Co-sponsored by Rep. Norton of Winthrop, Rep. Burke of Vassalboro, and Rep. Carroll of Gray. State and Local Government Hearing 01/24/90. Majority OTP-AM Accepted 03/02/90 (Minority ONTP). Amended by: CA (Changed Title) H-819, HA/CA H-849. Enacted. Pursuant to Joint Order SP 1012, this Bill was Recalled from the Governor's Desk. Final Disposition: Indefinitely Postponed.

Joint Order, That Bill "An Act to Return Positions within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to Classified Service under the Civil Service Law and to Establish Uniform Pay Schedules," HP 1380, LD 1911, be recalled from the Governor's desk to the Senate. Presented by Senator PEARSON of Penobscot. Final Disposition: Passed in Concurrence, 04/13/90.
