**History and Final Disposition**

HP1733

Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government consider proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine to eliminate barriers to democracy by amending the language that requires the votes of 2/3 of the members of each House to enact an emergency measure and by amending the language that requires the vote of 2/3 of the members of each House to override the veto of a measure by the Governor, and that the committee report out such legislation as it determines necessary to eliminate or reduce the requirement for a 2/3 vote. Presented by Representative MAHANY of Easton. In House: Passed; Adhered. In Senate: Indefinitely Postponed; Adhered. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 03/23/92.
