History and Final Disposition

HP1737

Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government consider proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Maine to provide that if no candidate for the office of Governor receives a majority of votes cast in an election for Governor, the House of Representatives shall select 2 candidates for the office from among those running and that the Legislature shall elect a Governor from the 2 candidates. Presented by Representative MAHANY of Easton. Final Disposition: Failed Passage in House 03/18/92.
