LD 430 / SP0175

An Act to Prevent Discrimination. Presented by Sen. Conley of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Stevens of Bangor, Sen. Gill of Cumberland, and Rep. O'Gara of Westbrook. Judiciary Hearing 03/18/91. Majority OTP-AM Accepted by Senate; Minority ONTP Accepted by House. Senate - Insisted on Engrossed as Amended by CA S-32; House - Adhered to ONTP. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 04/16/91.
