Original Title: An Act to Provide the Legislature with Revenue Forecasting Capabilities.
New Title: An Act to Improve the State's Fiscal Forecasting Capabilities. Presented by Sen. Pray of Penobscot; Co-sponsored by Sen. Brannigan of Cumberland, Rep. Chonko of Topsham, and Rep. Mayo of Thomaston. Appropriations & Financial Affairs Hearing 05/09/91. Recommitted to Appropriations & Financial Affairs. Died on Adjournment 07/10/91. Pursuant to Joint Order SP 782, this Bill was Recalled from the Legislative Files. Recommitted to Appropriations & Financial Affairs. Re-referred to State & Local Government. OTP-AM Accepted 03/28/92. Amended by: CB (Changed Title) S-733, SA/CB S-777. Enacted. Final Disposition: Veto Sustained 10/06/92.
