An Act to Promote the Marketing of Fresh Produce Grown Within the State. Presented by Rep. Kilkelly of Wiscasset; Co-sponsored by Rep. Barth, Jr. of Bethel, Rep. Spear of Nobleboro, and Sen. Holloway of Lincoln. House - Adhered to Reference to Agriculture; Senate - Adhered to Reference to Transportation. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 06/19/91.
