An Act to Clarify the Authority of Law Enforcement Officers to Release Certain Arrested Individuals on Their Personal Recognizance. Presented by Rep. Anthony of South Portland; Co-sponsored by Sen. Conley of Cumberland, and Rep. Paradis of Augusta. Legal Affairs Hearing 04/24/91. ONTP Accepted 05/07/91. Pursuant to Joint Order HP 1361, this Bill was Recalled from the Legislative Files. Bill Substituted for Report. Final Disposition: Enacted, Approved 06/30/91, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 521.
