LD 1310 / HP0913

An Act to Promote Fully Informed Legislation and Rulemaking. Presented by Rep. Foss of Yarmouth; Co-sponsored by Sen. Baldacci of Penobscot, Sen. Rich of Cumberland, and Rep. Small of Bath. State & Local Government Hearing 04/24/91. Minority ONTP Accepted in House; Majority OTP-AM Accepted in Senate. House - Adhered to ONTP; Senate - Engrossed as Amended by CA H-454. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 06/13/91.
