An Act to Authorize Financial Institutions and Credit Unions to Sell Annuities. Presented by Sen. Brannigan of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Gwadosky of Fairfield, and Rep. Erwin of Rumford. Banking & Insurance Hearing 04/11/91. Minority OTP-AM Accepted by House; Majority ONTP Accepted by Senate. House - Indefinitely Postponed. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 05/30/91.
