Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on Aging, Retirement and Veterans report out proposed legislation concerning the Maine State Retirement System including legislation regarding the age of retirement, the penalty for early retirement and the retirement health insurance benefit. Presented by Senator MCCORMICK of Kennebec. Final Disposition: Passed in Concurrence 05/07/91. (See LD 1935, LD 1936)
