LD 1975 / SP0779

An Act to Allow Agencies to Amend Legislative Agendas to Accommodate Unforeseen Events. Presented by Sen. Cahill of Sagadahoc. Died on Adjournment 07/10/91. Pursuant to Joint Order SP 785, this Bill was Recalled from the Legislative Files. Engrossed Without Reference. Amended by: HB H-781. Emergency Enactment Failed. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 07/18/91.
