LD 2005 / SP0806

An Act to Ensure that Certain Sales by Boy Scouting and Girl Scouting Organizations Are Exempt from the Sales Tax. Presented by Sen. Bost of Penobscot; Co-sponsored by Rep. Ruhlin of Brewer. Taxation Hearing 02/04/92. Minority OTP-AM Accepted 03/31/92 (Majority ONTP). Amended by: CA S-650. House - Failed Enactment; Senate - Indefinitely Postponed. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 03/31/92.
