HP1705

Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and Economic Development report out legislation designed to preserve jobs for Maine citizens and to make capital improvements to transportation and public infrastructure. Presented by Representative MELENDY of Rockland. Final Disposition: Passed in Concurrence 02/27/92. (See LD 2388, LD 2389)

LD 2388 / HP1707

An Act to Authorize Bond Issues for Transportation and Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements and Other Activities Designed to Create and Preserve Jobs for Maine Citizens. (Reported Pursuant to Joint Order HP 1705). Housing & Economic Development. Majority OTP Accepted 03/04/92 (Minority ONTP). Amended by SD S-594. Senate - Enactment Failed; House - Adhered to Enactment. Died Between Houses. Pursuant to Joint Order HP 1762, this Bill was Recalled from the Legislative Files. Amended by: HE H-1262. Enacted, Approved 04/09/92, P & S LAWS, Chapter 113. Final Disposition: Pt. A Approved in Referendum 06/09/92 (In favor: 103,718; Opposed: 66,358); Pt. B Approved in Referendum 06/09/92 (In favor: 98,577; Opposed: 69,611).

Joint Order, Recalling Bill "An Act to Authorize Bond Issues for Transportation and Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements and Other Activities Designed to Create and Preserve Jobs for Maine Citizens," HP 1707, LD 2388, from the legislative files to the Senate.
