An Act to Tighten Eligibility for the Maine Residents Property Tax Program. Presented by Rep. Butland of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Sen. Collins of Aroostook. Taxation Hearing 03/16/92. Majority ONTP Accepted in House (Minority OTP-AM); Indefinitely Postponed in Senate. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 03/30/92.
