Joint Resolution Supporting the United States Presence in the Persian Gulf. Presented by President PRAY of Penobscot; Cosponsored by: Speaker MARTIN of Eagle Lake, Senator CLARK of Cumberland, Senator WEBSTER of Franklin, Senator DUTREMBLE of York, Senator CAHILL of Sagadahoc, Representative GWADOSKY of Fairfield, Representative WHITCOMB of Waldo, Representative MAYO of Thomaston, and Representative MARSANO of Belfast. In Senate: Adopted. In House: Ruled improperly before the body. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 03/25/91.
