RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Require a 2/3 Affirmative Vote of the Entire Elected Membership of the Legislature to Increase State Income or Sales Tax. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Representative ZIRNKILTON of Mount Desert. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Taxation. Public Hearing 05/13/93. Final Disposition: Majority ONTP Accepted 06/01/93 (Minority OTP-AM).
