Resolve, Directing That the State's Coastal Zone Management Program Be Amended to Include Monitoring of Shellfish Harvesting Areas by the Department of Marine Resources. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Senator VOSE of Washington; Cosponsored by Senators: FOSTER of Hancock, PEARSON of Penobscot, Representatives: CHONKO of Topsham, FOSS of Yarmouth, KERR of Old Orchard Beach, MacBRIDE of Presque Isle, MITCHELL of Freeport, POULIOT of Lewiston, REED of Falmouth. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 06/04/93.
