An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Required Qualifications to Practice Law in the State. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Representative FOSS of Yarmouth; Cosponsored by Representative PARADIS of Augusta, Senator PEARSON of Penobscot and Representative: REED of Falmouth. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 01/20/94. OTP-AM Accepted 03/31/94. Amended by: CB H-957. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/08/94, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 643.
