An Act to Clarify that Incineration is a Form of Disposal under the State's Solid Waste Laws. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Representative JACQUES of Waterville; Cosponsored by Senator LAWRENCE of York and Representatives: ANDERSON of Woodland, COLES of Harpswell, GOULD of Greenville, LORD of Waterboro, Senator: CIANCHETTE of Somerset. Engrossed Without Reference 06/30/93. Final Disposition: Emergency Enacted, Signed 07/12/93, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 424.
