LD 1653 / SP0594

An Act to Enable the Use of Former Exit 5 on the Maine Turnpike for Access to an Adjacent Liquor Store and Hotel and Conference Center Facility. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.) Presented by President DUTREMBLE of York; Cosponsored by Senator SUMMERS of Cumberland, Representative NADEAU of Saco and Representatives: KERR of Old Orchard Beach, PENDLETON of Scarborough. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. Public Hearing 01/31/94. OTP-AM Accepted 03/22/94. Amended by: CA S-448. Final Disposition: Enacted, Signed 04/07/94, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 612.
