An Act to Establish a Complaint Procedure under the Maine Human Rights Act When a Conflict of Interest Exists. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.) Presented by Representative TREAT of Gardiner; Cosponsored by Senator CONLEY of Cumberland and Representatives: ADAMS of Portland, CHASE of China. FAIRCLOTH of Bangor, HOGLUND of Portland, PFEIFFER of Brunswick, RAND of Portland, Senator: ESTY of Cumberland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Public Hearing 02/23/94. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/22/94.
