Presented by Representative POULIN of Oakland; Cosponsored by Representatives: ANDERSON of Woodland, GOULD of Greenville, VIGUE of Winslow, Senators: CIANCHETTE of Somerset, LUDWIG of Aroostook. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/10/94.
