An Act to Reduce the Cost of Electricity and to Provide for Market Competition in the Production and Sales of Electricity. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.) Presented by Senator CLEVELAND of Androscoggin; Cosponsored by Representatives: ADAMS of Portland, KONTOS of Windham, MARTIN of Eagle Lake. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Utilities. Public Hearing 02/23/94. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/22/94.
