(Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.) Presented by Senator BRANNIGAN of Cumberland; Cosponsored by Senator: HARRIMAN of Cumberland, Representatives: BRENNAN of Portland, PENDEXTER of Scarborough, TOWNSEND of Portland. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources. Public Hearing 02/23/94. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/25/94.
