Presented by Representative CLARK of Millinocket; Cosponsored by Representatives: JALBERT of Lisbon, MORRISON of Bangor, SULLIVAN of Bangor TUFTS of Stockton Springs. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Aging, Retirement and Veterans. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: ONTP Accepted Pursuant to Joint Rule 15 03/10/94.
