An Act to Prohibit Registering to Vote on Election Day. Presented by Senator HALL of Piscataquis; Cosponsored by Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, CAREY of Kennebec, CARPENTER of York, CASSIDY of Washington, FERGUSON of Oxford, KIEFFER of Aroostook, PENDEXTER of Cumberland, STEVENS of Androscoggin, Representatives: BARTH of Bethel, DONNELLY of Presque Isle, HEINO of Boothbay. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. Public Hearing 02/22/95. House: Majority ONTP Accepted 03/09/95; Senate: Indefinite Postponement 03/07/95. Final Disposition: Died Between Houses 03/09/95.
